Please accept this letter as an official complaint against Mr. Stanowich regarding the inspection at Albany Cosmetic and Laser Centre and Westwood Pharmacy.

During the inspections Mr. Stanowich

- • Had no a clear purpose or objective for the inspections
- • Failed to remain respectful to a fellow member of the ACP
- • Was Abusive and humiliating to my staff and me, and showed an excessive threatening pattern to use his powers as an inspector
- • Failed to remain impartial by reporting only the negative findings
- • Took a personal attitude denying my competencies and education
- • Failed to collect relevant information to give a better analysis and conclusion about his inspection findings
- • Omitted material and documentation
- • Interfering with my clinical judgment in cases in fields outside his area of experience
- • Provided wrong interpretation of the ACP standards and bylaws in a clear scheme to misrepresent my practice and me
- • Urging the ACP council to propose an amendment regarding a restricted activity related to this inspection
- • Failed to show updated knowledge about the commonly used schedule I drug that is essential for patient care.
- • Failed to embrace the ACP educational approach, and to differentiate between intentional and unintentional mistakes.
- • Failed to maintain the privacy of the inspection by discussing the issue with Allergan and other vendors

The inability to start an investigation or inspection with the unbiased mindset and refusing to accept to embrace the dynamic nature of the health care professionals make him unfit to work for the ACP.
